Curry & Quiz Night



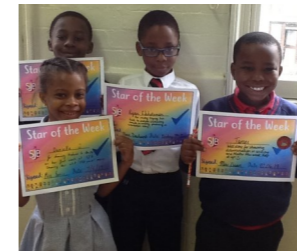
Come along for a plate of curry and a quiz **next Wednesday 19th June** from **5:00-**
