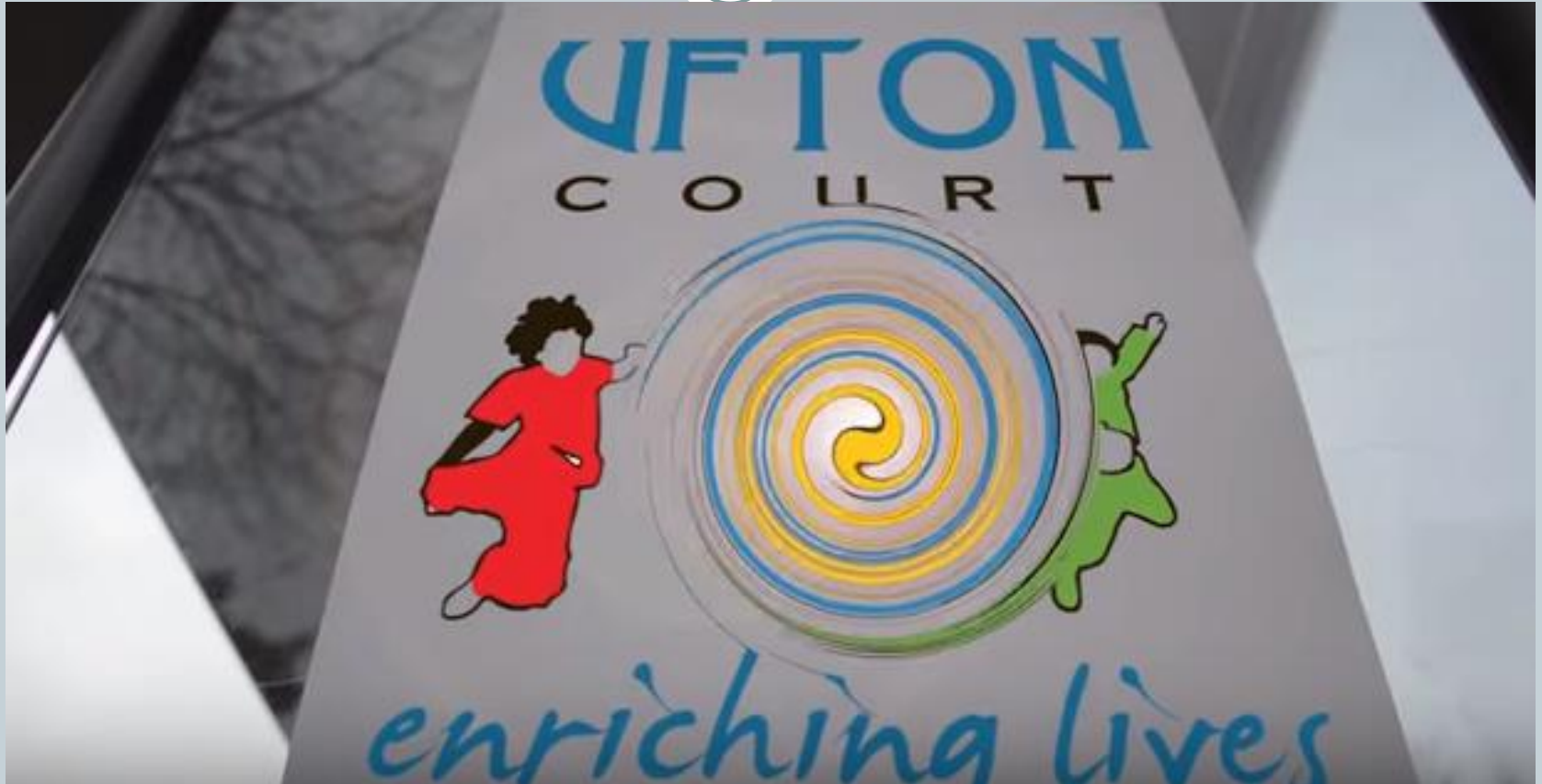

What do they do?

We help children immerse themselves in activities, helping them to:

- ✓ Develop a positive attitude to change, challenge and choice
- ✓ Aim high
- ✓ Be prepared for the challenges of the 21st century
- ✓ Spend more time outdoors
- ✓ Build and develop positive relationships
- ✓ Manage anxiety and depression
- ✓ Manage physical health – diet, sleep and exercise

What can they do for our children?



- They aim to support schools in giving children a passion for history and the outdoors.
- At Ufton Court, they give children the freedom to explore and discover as they become inspired by the exceptional historic environment and enjoy programmes led by Ufton Court's enthusiastic leaders.



What is the programme?



- Ufton court is a year-long three-part programme that challenges and inspires learning outside the classroom.
- **1 night stay: Monday 16th September**
- **2 night stay: Monday 16th December**
- **2 night stay: Wednesday 12th February**



What is the cost?

This is an exceptional opportunity that is being highly subsidised

- An initial deposit of £20.00 per child by Thursday 18th July 2019.
- Total cost: £100

Full and final payment will be due by Monday 9th September 2019.

What does this include?



- Travel

What will the children need to take?

General

- Waterproof coat or cagoule

- Set of clothes for each day. *(Make sure you bring a long sleeved top if you are doing Archery)*
- Underwear
- Socks
- Personal wash kit, brush/comb
- Towel
- Teddy bear *(Or other favourite cuddly toy)*
- Nightwear
- Dressing gown
- **WATER BOTTLE**
- Camera *(Please don't bring an expensive one)*
- Personal medication
- **Black tights / leggings and black shoes / plimsoles for the historical banquet.**
