
Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been invited to send a group of children on a residential programme to Ufton court in Reading, Berkshire.

You are being given the chance to apply for a place for your child. Ufton Court is an innovative charity that aims to support schools in giving children a passion for history and the outdoors. At Ufton Court, they give children the freedom to explore and discover.

Ufton court is a year-long three-part programme that challenges and inspires learning outside the classroom. From the exceptional house and grounds in Berkshire, they aim to raise aspiration and attainment of all children. They engage and challenge young people through physical and mental activities and embed new skills into their lives. They focus on increasing children's confidence and return young people to school physically and emotionally equipped to take advantage of opportunities and manage their emotions.

The residential programme consists of an initial one night stay in September 2019, followed by two, 2 night stays in December 2019 and February 2020. This is an exceptional opportunity for our children but there is very **limited availability**.



We are inviting your child on this programme. If we have more applications than places, then we will randomly select children.

The total cost of the programme (for all three trips) has been heavily subsidised and is £100. This price includes travel, full board, accommodation and insurance. Your child will need to agree to attend **all three trips** as this is the package being offered.

We will be having two briefing sessions on **Monday 8th July 2019 at 9am** and a repeat session on **Tuesday 9th July at 3pm** so we can give you the required information and answer any questions you may have.

We are required to give definite numbers and a deposit of £20.00 per child by Thursday 18th July 2019. This will secure your child's place then arrangements for payments can be made weekly or in one lump sum. **Full and final payment will be due by Monday 9th September 2019.**



If you would like your child to be part of this programme, to secure their place, please complete the slip below and attach the deposit of £20 in cash and return it to the school office **no later than Thursday 18th July 2019.**

- * Places must be secured with the deposit.
